



Live Scouting's Adventure

2017 National Jamboree – Summit Bechtel Reserve July 19 – 28, 2017

Over 40,000 acres in the New River Gorge comprise the permanent home of the National Scout Jamboree and BSA's fourth High Adventure base. There are over 9 miles of Zip Lines, 6 acres of Shooting Sports, Whitewater Rafting and more activities than you can imagine for 10 days.

The Atlanta Area Council is forming 6 Jamboree Troops and 2 Venturing Crews to take a total of 232 Youth to represent our Council and Atlanta at the 2017 National Scout Jamboree.

Boy Scout Participant Qualifications are: Must have a current BSA membership and be at least a First Class Scout. The Boy Scout must be at least 12 years old by the first day of the Jamboree and not yet 18 by the last day of the Jamboree. The Scout should by the time of the Jamboree have at least one long term camp (like summer camp) experience prior to the Jamboree.

Venturing Participants: must have a current BSA membership with a local Venturing crew.
